

This is an example of the type of dialogues I have had with other Christians. I post it here so you can see how some Christians respond to having their public comments about politics challenged. They want to be allowed to express their opinions, but they become offended when their views are challenged.

These are our communications on my page and the few on her page. At the end you can see, she reported me even after I had already agreed not to contact her any longer.

I am using a fake name for her to protect her identity. As my intention is not to expose her, but only her disposition. Here I call her Eve Baxter.

Eve Baxter- to me on my page

Biden seems to have a better plan for unity. President Trump seemed to have no plan for unity. I will not read or listen to past events of either man. I listened to and watched their actions recently.

Danzil Monk to Eve

Sis. I respect that point. But most people are only exposed to media attacks that are fabricated, exaggerated or out of context. What you are getting from media is a narrative, which spins the point to feed you a view, not report the facts in context. My point is that these Biden issues were not reported by the left media and people who think Biden is upstanding are unaware of them. If you think Trump has

no plan for unity I need you to ask yourself why? I watch the media as you, but not just the many left media but also right media and political experts of history and when you hear them discuss what is going on in the media, you get a more clear idea of that is happening. Why is it that I have seen and heard Trumps plan for unity and you have not? When he speaks of making America Great again, he was speaking about taking care of America first then others and not allowing others to take from us. He also said that by having a strong economy we all benefited so we would not unnecessarily give millions to hostile countries any longer or international interest that did not benefit us. He has never spoke against unity, it has only been the left that has accused him of doing so. they'll bring on some other stranger to report the vote and his projections. Spew vitriol, hate, and spin narratives. And to seriously turn it off to save his mental health. I recommend you do the same.

Danzil Monk to Nora and Eve

(she did not reply, she just threw a rock and ran)

Danzil Monk to Nora Pope

Labeled? My sister how did you get "labeled" from what I said? And how can you "exit" on a mistaken assumption? That concerns me. "not quite biblical"- require a response that shows why I am incorrect, not assume that I am labeling you and exit. I did explain what I meant by my statement, so all you had to do is explain why I am incorrect. Or ask me to clarify. I have made an effort to be respectful and so I am not clear as to how you arrived at your conclusion about me labeling you or even leaning towards doing so.

Eve Baxter To Danzil Monk

I hope you know that I respect you. I listened to both candidates. **Based on what I heard, I feel more**

comfortable with change. It is not based on what the media says. But I have had people from both camps on my Facebook page sending me things about both candidates. For the most part, I chose to delete the information for both without reading or listening to it. I deleted one person, who kept sending things about the police being justified in how they handle some people. I do understand politics. I will be watching all elected officials, not just the President elect and Vice President Elect. Local elections are just as important.

Danzil Monk to Eve

Danzil Monk to Eve you said:

You Said:

So I need to know what does that has brought you to your conclusion of Biden over Trump. Please help me understand. We can talk by phone instead of here if you prefer.

Eve you said:

“I don't debate with people about their political views either. It is not productive.”

I agreed, but I then stressed the necessity of communication and dialogue and you did not reply. Was I wrong? Since I did not describe our dialogue as a “debate” I am not sure why that word came up. It is usually used to describe a discussion in which two people disagree, but that is incorrect. It should not be applied to a discussion.

You said:

“ My whole life is based on my views as a Christian. I do not separate the two, so you are wrong in that regard.”

But I did not address your view as a Christian, I said you were not quite looking at this biblically, there is a difference. I then explained my point, so I am not sure how you missed my point.

You said:

“I have listened to President Trump and watched his actions. It seems I have a different view of his leadership than you. I do not see him as a unifier or for all people.”

And you are certainly entitled to your opinion sis. I am just asking you to explain to me what you base that on. You have given me no actual example. I am trying to understand how you arrived at your

conclusion and why we disagree. That is important to me. Is it possible that we are viewing different material? What has Biden said and done that makes him a BETTER choice than Trump? And what has Trump actually done that makes him a worst choice than Biden?

(These are reasonable questions I thought).

not say don't post on my page. I asked you to stop tagging me in your political posts. I respect you but I will not debate these issues. I have read your comments. I have watched some of the videos you post. My opinion has not changed. Oil and water.

Danzil to Eve:

Sis. I fully respect your right to your opinion. And I would never deny you that. My concern is that as a Christian we are all required by God to be honest and to represent people fairly and accurately. AS you here have corrected my misunderstanding about commenting on your page. I failed to heed your actual words and assumed more than you intended. I accept that correction. But you also said that you "saw no point in these conversations". I take that to mean that trying to help a Christian to carefully evaluate what they say publicly, is pointless.

I don't agree it is pointless, since the Bible teaches us to help others who error or misrepresent the truth about matters. I do so out of concern for our example to the world and our obligation to God and his Word. That is love, to say nothing is not love and to reject correction is not love. I have only sought to help you to understand how important being accurate is in your public comments. If that offends you, I am saddened. I love you and want the best for you, and I expect you to also seek to help me stay in line with God's word. If that disturbs you, I will no longer comment, because I do not want to offend you. I only addressed your posts because you stated your support for them and they contained information that was not true or fair.

Spiritually that is a serious matter for us as believers. I am concerned that "objection" and "denial" was your reply rather than an explanation as to why you were correct to edify me. I

have always esteemed you as a sister who loved God and his truth. I never saw you as being sensitive to challenges to your views, or to correction. Am I in error?

(I received no reply)

Eve Posted a video on her page of a Christian minister who was claiming to be balanced, but who basically expressed negative comments about Trump that were not at all balanced or fair. And I watched it and replied to it. And I notified her of my reply via messenger, without posting it on her page. I also did not mention her name in my page post of the video.

(This was my page post)

I AM SHARING THIS FROM A CHRISTIAN SISTER'S PAGE WHO HAS ASKED ME NOT TO TAG HER PAGE ANY LONGER WITH POLITICAL CONTENT. AND SHE DOES NOT WANT TO BE QUESTIONED ABOUT IT WHAT SHE POSTS ON HER PAGE. SO, I NATURALLY COMPLIED WITH HER REQUEST. IT IS SAD THAT SOME CHRISTIANS HAVE ADAPTED THE SAME MIND SET AS THE WORLD, "DON'T CHALLENGE MY OPINION JUST AGREE WITH ME OR LEAVE ME ALONE". THIS VIDEO AND THE BROTHER WHO IS DELIVERING THE MESSAGE IS A GOOD EXAMPLE OF SOME CHRISTIANS WHO "CLAIM" TO BE ONLY SPEAKING FROM THE BIBLE AND DEFENDING GOD'S WAY, WHILE BEING BIAS AND UNBALANCE. IT IS LIKE TALKING OUT OF BOTH SIDES OF YOUR MOUTH, BUT SAYING IT IN A

WAY THAT SEEMS TO BE SINCERE AND "NICE". SO AFTER WATCHING THE VIDEO, I REPLIED TO IT AND SENT MY REPLY TO HIM VIA HIS WEBSITE ON FEB.5, 2021. I HAVE NOT RECEIVED A RESPONSE, AND SO I POSTED MY REPLY ON HIS FB VIDEO PAGE YESTERDAY. I AM POSTING MY REPLY HERE AS WELL. SO YOU SEE, IT IS NOT ONLY THE CRAZY LEFT THAT WE HAVE TO WATCH, BUT EVEN CHRISTIANS WHO THINK THEY ARE HELPING. WE AS CHRISTIANS HAVE TO BE WATCHFUL AND PAY CAREFUL ATTENTION TO HOW OUR BROTHERS AND SISTERS EXPRESS THEMSELVES, AND NOT JUST ASSUME THAT BECAUSE THEY SOUND "KIND", THAT THEY ARE SPEAKING CORRECTLY. This is the reply I sent to the speaker:

My reply to your Wednesday Word January 13, 2021. January 13th Face Book message. I agree with the obligations of Believers to facilitate unity (true unity with people who want to do right), stand up for biblical truth and be examples of what

God called us to be. But I would like to know how you seek to reach your goal or be faithful to your stated agenda, if you are not fair and balanced. IF your thinking is also influenced by leftist narratives and spins of what is done and said by leaders, how can you be trusted to deliver a balanced message that will direct people to a solid biblical display of godliness?

You say that God was cleaning house by removing Trump "because he was proud etc." but you ignored the fact that his predecessors and successors may well have demonstrated greater evil as well as pride only out of public view, via their policies and God only knows the back room deals that were made.. For you to teach that Trump was removed for his pride "by God" using his "Pride" as gauged by his bold open and some times foolish comments, that other Presidents practiced off camera and out of the press, and THAT GOD WOULD HAVE ALSO BEEN AWARE OF, seem to me to be a bit presumptuous.

Since your stated goal is to unify and side with what is biblicly right, should you not be balanced with your observations? To denounce Trump for his boldness, "arrogance" outspokenness and any other faults you perceive, without doing the same to the left Press, Big Tech, Hollywood, Network talk-show hosts, our Public education system, Critical theorist, those who preach intersectionality, race baiters etc., all of whom contribute to the influence of the public, is not accomplishing what you say your goal is to be balanced and fair.

When you side with any evil or unrighteousness or fail to be balanced in your presentation, you give reason for suspicion and that is why I am contacting you. I know none of us are perfect, but I have seen so many “good intentions” in history and in my life time, morph into just another special interest religious movement that is controlled by evil people with money. It seems

that everyone has their price, and I am hoping you are not such a person.

I encourage you to take more time evaluating your comments before you make them in public, and be willing to acknowledge when you have mis-spoken and correct it so that you will not be justly accused of “Pride”, “Arrogance” or any other negative justly.

I believe I see what you seek to accomplish, and it is commendable. But it is not so easy, and the most difficult aspect of it will be to strive to be “sound in speech, that cannot be condemned (truthfully).

I pray that you do not take my comments here as an attack on you or your efforts to do something godly, it is not. I just seek to push you in the right direction. God knows we need great examples in church leadership, and there are far too few. But then, these are the last days.

(Note: I never received a reply from him, even though I posted it on his page and emailed it to him, I also called his ministry and left a voice message informing them of my sent reply).

My FB private messages to Eve

Eve, you are welcome to call me any time to talk. XXX-XXX-XXXX. What is going on on social media demands a sound Christian voice, with so many deceiver, disrupters, God haters and poor Christian examples living there, I am only trying to be a voice in the wilderness. There is clearly not enough sound

Christian content or good Christian examples on social media. If I error, please feel free to correct me, I welcome it. But you should also be prepared to demonstrate why I am wrong. That is the Christian way. Agreed? We can talk any time please feel free to call me.

I love you my sister. Please pray for me as I pray for you.

Eve to me.

I will keep you and your family in prayer!!! And thank you for praying for me!!!

Eve Baxter posted:

She posted a video of Arnold Schwarzenegger using his past personal bad experiences to gain sympathy and trust and then trashing Trump, using unsound accusations to do so.

Titled: (My message to my fellow Americans and friends around the world following this week's attack on the Capitol)

Eve replied to the anti- Trump video on her page:

“Exactly!!!”

(Meaning she fully agreed with Arnold Schwarzenegger)

So I replied to her:

Danzil Monk to Eve:

I agree with some of what he says here and strongly disagree with other things he says here. But I am more concerned that Christians are simply agreeing with the entire message without reasonable or even fair evaluation. It is like their minds are trained to accept what the Left media says without question. That to me is disturbing. I watch Christians and listen to them make statements and repeat accusations with no convictions about the accuracy of the statements or no concern about the truth of the statement. And that concerns me. Even worst, when they are asked to defend their support for such statements and accusations, they refuse to do so and just continue to repeat their support for the misrepresentation and inaccuracy with no conviction, and then accuse those who ask for their justification of being crazy, a cult or foolish for not agreeing with their perspective. The Bible tells us to "prove all things and hold fast to that which is good (2 Thess. 5:21) Proving is not just repeating what someone says but establishing why what they say is correct or true. That some Christians refuse to understand this is disturbing. I have seen Christians who were disturbed by the blind thinking of Atheist, demonstrate that same blindness when it comes to their faith in leftist media. Such Christians will cut you off and avoid you while claiming to love you, just because you insist that they prove their convictions and not just post them and repeat them. They don't seem to care that their errors are affecting others and they are accountable for how they affect others to believe what is not true or is inaccurate. We will all give account to God for what we say and what we do. Thinking you are correct and being correct is not the same thing. And being offended

(Note: In spite of this agreement, she felt it necessary to report me to my church leadership, that speaks volumes about her intentions).

For Christians to get on Social media and speak their mind, not only on their page, but on the page of others, and expect not to be challenged and held accountable for what they say is foolish. But this happens a lot.
